Being Faithful in Service

Verses: Matt. 25:20-24; Zech. 4:10; John 6:5-13.

Matt. 25:20 And he who had received the five talents came and brought another five talents, saying, Master, you delivered to me five talents; behold, I have gained another five talents.

Matt. 25:21 His master said to him, Well [done,] good and faithful slave. You were faithful over a few things; I will set you over many things. Enter into the joy of your master.

Matt. 25:22 And he [who had received] the two talents also came and said, Master, you delivered to me two talents; behold, I have gained another two talents.

Matt. 25:23 His master said to him, Well [done,] good and faithful slave. You were faithful over a few things; I will set you over many things. Enter into the joy of your master.

Matt. 25:24 Then he who had received the one talent also came and said, Master, I knew about you, that you are a hard man, reaping where you did not sow, and gathering where you did not winnow.

Zech. 4:10 For who has despised the day of small things? For these seven rejoice when they see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel; they are the eyes of Jehovah running to and fro on the whole earth.

John 6:5 Jesus then lifting up His eyes and seeing that a great crowd was coming toward Him, said to Philip, Where shall we buy bread that these may eat?

John 6:6 But this He said to test him, for He Himself knew what He was about to do.

John 6:7 Philip answered Him, Two hundred denarii worth of bread is not sufficient for them, that each one may take a little.

John 6:8 One of His disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, said to Him,

John 6:9 There is a little boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish; but what are these for so many?

John 6:10 Jesus said, Have the people recline. Now there was much grass in the place. So the men reclined, in number about five thousand.

John 6:11 Jesus then took the loaves, and when He had given thanks, He distributed to those who were reclining; likewise also of the fish, as much as they wanted.

John 6:12 And when they were filled, He said to His disciples, Gather the broken pieces left over that nothing may be lost.

John 6:13 So they gathered [them] and filled twelve handbaskets with broken pieces from the five barley loaves which were left over among those who had eaten.
