Verses: 2 Tim. 4:8; Psalm 37:4-5; Matt. 24:45-51; Rom. 11:36; Matt. 25:27; Exo. 21:5

2 Tim. 4:8 Henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, with which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will recompense me in that day, and not only me but also all those who have loved His appearing.

Psalm 37:4 Delight yourself in Jehovah, And He will give you the requests of your heart.

Psalm 37:5 Commit your way to Jehovah, And trust in Him; and He will act.

Matthew 24:45 Who then is the faithful and prudent slave, whom the master has set over his household to give them food at the proper time?

Matthew 24:46 Blessed is that slave whom his master, when he comes, will find so doing.

Matthew 24:47 Truly I say to you that he will set him over all his possessions

Matthew 24:48 But if that evil slave says in his heart, My master delays,

Matthew 24:49 And begins to beat his fellow slaves and eats and drinks with the drunken,

Matthew 24:50 The master of that slave will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour which he does not know,

Matthew 24:51 And will cut him asunder and appoint his portion with the hypocrites. In that place there will be the weeping and the gnashing of teeth.

Rom. 11:36 Because out from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. To Him be the glory forever. Amen.

Matt. 25:27 Therefore you should have deposited my money with the money changers; and when I came, I would have recovered what is mine with interest.

Exo. 21:5 I love my master...I will not go out free.
