

<u>Covid-19 Guidelines for Oak Glen Christian Conference Center</u> Guests

In accordance with San Bernardino Public Health Department and CDC, Oak Glen Christian Conference Center is implementing the following guidelines for the safety and health of our guests and staff.

- 1. All guests must use hand sanitizer immediately prior to going through the food line.
- 2. It is strongly recommended that all guests, regardless of vaccine status, continue masking indoors and while going through the food lines.
- 3. Hand washing should be done frequently. Hand sanitizer should be used when washing with soap and water is not available.
- 4. Close interaction between groups is not encouraged or recommended.
- 5. Each group is required to provide a leader with current medical certification in First Aid and CPR. This health supervisor must do a thorough health screening within the 24 hours prior to arrival at camp. Any camper running a fever or showing symptoms of being ill or exposure to illness should not attend camp. The health screening forms must be turned in at check-in with your liability forms.
- 6. During camp, the health supervisor must log daily temperature checks for each camper. The Camp Director should be notified immediately if any guest runs a fever or shows other symptoms of being ill. In addition, the symptomatic camper should be immediately isolated from all other guests. The completed temperature log should be turned into the camp office on the last day of the retreat along with the guest evaluation.
